The National University of Technology (NUTECH), Islamabad, has welcomed 124 Afghan male & female students under its Specialized Zero-Semester Program. This program is part of the Allama Iqbal Scholarship, fully funded by HEC, Pakistan, and is designed to prepare students for their further undergraduate studies.
